

Hello 4-H Senior members,

4-H State Conference is June 19-22 at CSU in Ft. Collins and is for all Senior age 4-H members. Registration is now OPEN. Please register early so you can pick the workshops you would like to attend – the good ones fill up fast. Registration is through [4Honline](#) and closes May 16th (no late registrations excepted).

Registration will look very different this year. There is a flat \$90 registration fee for all attendees and everything else is a la carte (meals, lodging, workshops, competitions). Attached is a worksheet that will help you navigate through the registration process (fill this out before going into [4Honline](#) to register as a guide). Also on the state [website](#) you will find contest information, [schedule](#), [workshop descriptions](#) and much more.

Routt County 4-H will be providing transportation for our members. We will be leaving on Tuesday morning, June 19 and returning Friday, June 22. Our Routt County Leadership funds will cover \$30 per night of each member attending. (Ex. – if you are staying Tuesday-Thursday night then we will cover \$90 of your registration fees. If you are staying just one night then we will cover \$30 of your registration fees.) If you are attending State Conference then you will take part in all scheduled activities. Be sure to pick workshops and contests to fill all the time slots while you are there. If you leave them blank, then I will pick the workshops for you.

Meals – You will be needing meals starting Tuesday night (pizza party) through Friday morning breakfast. The only exception will be County Night Out on Thursday night (Routt County 4-H will pay for this night). There is an evening awards banquet this year on Wednesday night. Some contests will include lunch.

Lodging – You will need lodging Tuesday-Thursday night (not Monday night).

Workshops – the [workshop descriptions](#) can be found on the state website. Sign up early for these because the good ones fill up fast. You must pick workshops to fill all your empty slots (no down time). And you must attend all the workshops you signed up for.

Contest – we encourage you to participate in contests if you would like. You can see a description of them on the state [website](#). Note – Livestock Quiz Bowl begins at 10am on Tuesday this year. If we have a team we will need to be on the road by 6am.
