#### Secretary Minutes

The first Routt County Council meeting was held on January 9, 2019 at SoRoCo High School in Oak Creek. Before the meeting started, there was a parliamentary procedure workshop that started at 7:00 and ended at 7:46 pm. The workshop was put on by Jay Whaley, and helped by two FFA members, Grace Olinger and Kaetlyn Friedman. The meeting was called to order at 7:46 with the pledges led by Jess and Sophie Diehl. Roll call was then read, with the most members in attendance from Southside 4-H Club. The reading of the minutes was dispensed to the next meeting by Kaetlyn F. and seconded by Justin H. The treasurer's report was read by Justin Heid who stated that the council's account balance is at \$6,252.75. It was moved by Emmitt M. and seconded by Justin H. The reporter's report was dispensed due to the absence of the reporter, moved by Sophie D. and Ezra G. Club reports were given by the Elk River Wranglers, Fairplay, Flat Tops, Handy Lads and Lassies, High Point, Ranch House, and Southside. The only old business discussed was council officer contracts that needed to be turned in. In new business, the council read the updates to the 2019 Routt County 4-H Member Handbook. The first motion was made by Emmitt M. and seconded by Justin H. During discussion, an amendment to the change on page 13 was made changing the word "show" to "entry". This amendment was moved by Grace O. and seconded by Jess D. From there, the council discussed upcoming fundraisers, record books, and project requirements. There was then a reminder about the IDing of 4-H animals for the new year, as well as talking about the Cowboy Downhill Petting Zoo. There were reminders for weigh ins, 4-H ski day, livestock judging, vet science, and NWSS. The meeting was drawn to a close by talking about upcoming leadership conferences and the reminder that all animals going to state fair need to be nominated and get a retinal scan. The meeting was adjourned at 8:27 pm.
