

Routt County 4-H Continuing Education Scholarships

Considerations:

1. Recipients will be selected based on the criteria of the scholarship selection committee as requested in the scholarship application.
2. Continuing Education scholarship application, including two current letters of recommendation (dated and within the last 6 months), must be submitted by 5pm on April 1. If you are needing to mail any documents, they must be at the Extension Office by April 1 (not posted marked by April 1). Mailing address: CSU Extension, 136 6th Street, Steamboat Springs, CO 80487.
3. Recipients are limited to receive one 4-H scholarship per year for up to four years.
4. If the student was awarded a previous 4-H scholarship and is applying for a continuing education scholarship, then the following proof will be required from the student:
 - a. Enrollment in college or university during the time the scholarship is to be paid.
 - b. Eligibility (full-time student in good standing with the college or university and not on academic probation).
5. If the student was awarded a previous 4-H scholarship and is applying for a continuing education scholarship, then the following information will be verified by the Extension Office and/or 4-H Foundation:
 - a. Receipt of thank you note for any previous scholarship monies
 - b. Was a 4-H member in good standing their final year of 4-H (completed all enrolled projects).
 - c. Volunteer leadership participation in at least one 4-H activity in the last year:

6. The scholarship foundation reserves the right to review eligibility status and refuse/award monies at their discretion. Money must be used for tuition, student fees, recipient room & board and/or books.

Available Scholarships (all of which are \$1,000 each but may be allocated differently should the scholarship committee so choose – ie 2 scholarships of \$500 each, etc.):

1. **Helen Sherrod Memorial Scholarship:** Reward a 4-H member who is attending a Colorado college or university with a specific emphasis in the family and consumer science area and has demonstrated a commitment to the Routt County 4-H program and other constructive youth programs. \$1,000
2. **Howard and Maxine Elliot Memorial Scholarship:** Reward two previous 4-H members who are continuing his/her education toward a first undergraduate degree at a Colorado college or university. \$1,000
3. **Pud Stetson Memorial Scholarship:** Reward a 4-H member who has demonstrated a commitment to the Routt County 4-H program and other constructive youth programs and is pursuing a career in agriculture and/or business. Student must have a cumulative college GPA of at least 3.5. \$1,000
4. **Jim Milligan Scholarship:** Reward a previous 4-H member who has demonstrated a commitment to the Routt County 4-H program and other constructive youth programs and is pursuing a career in agriculture. \$1,000
5. **Routt County 4-H Scholarship:** Reward a 4-H member who has demonstrated a commitment to the Routt County 4-H program and other constructive youth programs. \$1,000
6. **Sam Haslem Memorial Scholarship:** To reward a 4-H member who has demonstrated a commitment to the Routt County 4-H program and other constructive youth programs. \$1,000

7. **Summers 4-H Scholarship:** Reward a 4-H member who has demonstrated a commitment to the Routt County 4-H program and other constructive youth programs and is continuing his/her education toward a first undergraduate degree. \$1,000
