

**There are some important changes to the Junior Livestock Sale Rules for 2022.**

1. Every consignment (ie. large animal, or pen of small animals) will be charged up to \$115 for sale expenses. This number may be less based on sale expenses and/or sponsorships secured. This money will be deducted from the sale check. Each year, the youth pay a fee for each sale consignment. Last year was a percentage, years prior were a flat fee and after much research and discussion, the committee chose to return to the flat fee.
2. Each youth may consign only one large animal and only one pen of small animals, unless you win a grand or reserve champion, when you may be able to sell additional.

Complete rules with additional details will be posted to the 4-H website by the end of the week in the 4-H Handbook, under the Junior Livestock Auction.
