Routt County 4-H Post-Secondary Scholarships

Considerations:

- 1. Applicants for post-secondary scholarships must have a high school diploma or GED certificate.
- 2. Recipients will be selected based on the criteria of the scholarship selection committee as requested in the scholarship application.
- 3. Recipients are limited to receive 4-H scholarship money four times.
- 4. Money <u>must</u> be used for tuition, student fees, recipient room & board and/or books and will be sent directly to the college, university or school. Recipient will provide verification of enrollment status and transcripts before payment of monies.
- 5. The following information will be required from the student applying for a post-secondary scholarship:
 - a. Post-secondary scholarship application per instructions on application site.
 - b. Full-time enrollment in college or university during the time the scholarship is to be paid.
 - c. Eligibility (full-time student in good standing with the college or university and not on academic probation).
- 6. The following information will be verified by the Extension Office and/or 4-H Foundation:
 - a. Has applicant completed three or more years as a member of Routt County 4-H in good standing, including their senior year of high school.
 - b. If s/he has previously received a 4-H Foundation scholarship, did s/he participate in and fulfill their obligations to volunteer for at least one 4-H activity in the last year: Exhibit Day, Routt County Fair, Annual 4-H Scholarship Foundation Fundraiser or Jr. Livestock Sale.
- 7. The scholarship foundation reserves the right to review eligibility status and refuse/award monies at their discretion.
