What do Cloverbuds do?

4-H Cloverbuds programs are:

- Activity focused and not project focused
- built on cooperative learning, rather than competitive activities
- varied to develop specific skills or concepts

4-H Cloverbuds members participate in non-competitive, sampler type, age appropriate, properly supervised events or activities lead by the 4-H Junior Leaders.

Why Cloverbuds?

The overall puropose of the 4-H Cloverbuds program is to foster the development of life skills that are essential for the cognitive, social, emotional and physical maturation of Kindergarten through 3rd graders by providing a unique educational opportunity.

Additional Notes:

- Cloverbud age youth and younger are not allowed to participate in any 4-H Shooting Sports activity
- Cloverbud youth are not allowed to participate in any 4-H camps or overnight camps
- Cloverbud youth do not participate in activities of handling animals, or animal project
- Cloverbud youth are not eligible for premiums or ribbons as a result of competition; however, they can receive ribbons for participation

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
