Routt County 4-H enrolls around 270+ youth and 80+ leaders a year. Our volunteer 4-H leaders support our youth through our clubs, as project leaders, chaperones, shooting sports leaders and much more. Learn what Routt County 4-H has to offer you.

There are four easy steps to enrolling in 4-H:

Pick a CLUB

- **What is a club?** – We have 9 county clubs across Routt County. The clubs meet monthly to complete community service projects, fundraising and club meetings.
- **Club meetings are a requirement of being in 4-H** so make sure you put these dates on your calendar now.
- Families usually pick a club based on which club has your friends in it or which club meetings dates/times works best for your family schedule. Club meetings are not project based.

Pick a PROJECT(S)

- We recommend that new members select between 1 and 3 projects for their first year.

- **4-H Enrollment Fees –**
 - Enrollment is \$40
 - \$5 additional for horse

- \$25 additional for shooting sports
- \$15 total for Cloverbuds
- \$30 late fee for all returning members who are not enrolled and paid by December 31, 2023.
