AT 11am, or when 4-H officials say, livestock pens can be broken down and disassembled. Please wait for instruction! When the barn is all broken down and cleaned, you will check out with Tami or Millie.  
Small Animal Barn - members with small animals need to be at the SAB to help clean. All animals need to be removed by noon. If you have animals in the MPB and SAB, please communicate with your superintendents so they know when you will be there to help clean and break down.

Horse members can meet at the Green Horse Stalls to help clean pens. All Horse members must check out with Tami or Millie after you have cleaned your horse stall. This can take place any time during fair.
